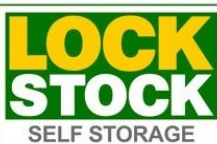

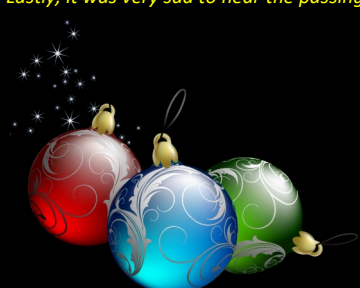

The home side started brightest and worked the ball well from side to side throughout, causing many problems all day, however, Dolgellau played to the conditions best. The Town were penned in their own half and Guto Pugh excellently broke up the play and matched that with a brilliantly weighted ball through for Osian Morris to carry, round the keeper, and put Dolgellau in the lead. Shortly after Harri Davies deals with a long ball, heading it clear, then hooked on by Rob Evans which Osian plucked from the sky, got within shooting range and buried it bottom corner. Again, Dolgellau dealt with the pressure, and Nathan Morris was able to release a ball down the channel into Osian's path who was then floored in the penalty area. Osian dust himself off to dispatch the penalty, securing himself a first half hat-trick. Annoyingly, we conceded just before half time which then gave the team a very testing first 10 minutes in the second half. From nowhere, Cefn Albion then gifted Dolgellau and Osian a fourth goal as the back line and keeper tried to play from the back where Osian was on hand to close down and deflect the keeper's effort to clear goalwards and in. Cefn didn't give in and Dol had to be dogged throughout. We had some chances on the break and the main one coming to Osian to score his fifth after Guto directing the ball goalwards from outside the box into Osian's path to smash in the net. An unbelievable performance away from home with so many players missing through injury and suspension, and for Osian to do what he did the day after representing his country, is purely magical. A win that keeps Dolgellau on top of the league

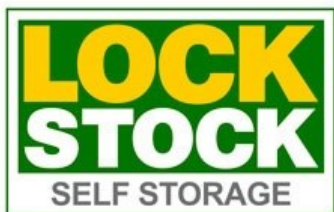

Builth Wells Football Club club was formed in 1879.

In 1988-89 the club joined the Mid-Wales League but left the league in 2000

In 2010-11 the club re-joined Mid-Wales League from the Mid-Wales League (South). In 2014 the club were relegated to Division Two.

In 2017-18 the club were Mid-Wales League Division Two Champions, and were subsequently promoted to Division One.

For the 2020-21 season the team played in the newly formed Mid Wales League East Division (the fourth tier of the Welsh football pyramid). They finished the season in second place and were subsequently promoted.

In 2022-23 the club will play in the Ardal North East League (the third tier of the Welsh football pyramid).
